Microsoft Sunset Date for Windows XP Announced – April 8, 2014

Microsoft has announced April 8, 2014 as the sunset date for support of the Windows XP operating system. More information on this announcement is available [here](#).

What impact will the sunset date for Windows XP have on APL+Win and the add-on Windows products like APLNext APL WebServices, APLNext Database Interface Tools, APLNext Supervisor and APL+Link Pro?

Versions of the products released prior to the Microsoft sunset date for Windows XP will continue to operate in Windows XP. However, APL2000 will cease to support those versions of the products after the Microsoft sunset date for Windows XP. Additionally, future releases of APL2000 products for the Windows operating system will be designed for and supported in the Windows 7, Windows 8, Server 2008 and subsequent operating systems.

What should be done to prepare for the Microsoft sunset date for Windows XP?

APL2000 encourages our customers to migrate APL+Win and its add-on products to the Windows 7 or Windows 8 operating system. In most cases, this will simply require the installation of APL+Win and the add-on products in Windows 7 or Windows 8.
